Dear Patient,

You may be aware that some vaccines and immunisations recommended for travel are not readily available under the NHS, and your G.P. is entitled to charge you a private fee for the cost of and the administration of any required vaccine for the purpose of travel abroad.

Appointments

Travel clinics are held weekly on Wednesday afternoons, between 2 and 6pm, and occasionally at other times. Our clinics are very busy and it is essential that you contact the surgery for your appointment/s at least 8-10 weeks before you intend to travel, to allow sufficient appointments for your individual travel health needs. Long stay travellers may require several appointments prior to travelling, so it is essential to contact us well in advance.

Yellow Fever Vaccinations

This Practice is also a designated Department of Health Yellow Fever Centre. We provide the required International Yellow Fever certificates free of charge, at the time of vaccination.

Fee Structure:

The private immunisation fee is made up of the cost of the vaccine and an administration fee. The administration fee covers injections unavailable on the NHS, whether a single injection or booster, or a complete course of injections (usually 3 or 4). The full fee is payable prior to commencing administration of the vaccine (s).

Any medicines required for use outside of the UK, such as antibiotics taken 'just in case' will attract a private prescription and this will be charged at £14.50.

Malaria Prophylaxis

Malaria requirements for your destination will be discussed at your appointment. Whilst some malaria prophylaxis can be purchased from the chemist directly, others may need to be privately prescribed by the doctor. These private prescriptions are charged at £14.50 per individual prescription / per patient. The pharmacist will advise you of the cost of the malaria prophylaxis.

Payment

The practice welcomes payment by cash or cheque (accompanied with current cheque guarantee card). Regrettably, we are unable to accept credit or debit card payments.
